Class 1 **Equissage Pulse Senior British Novice - First Round**

Entry Fee - £12.00

Rule 316. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 90cm.

- For registered horses in Grade C not to have won a total of 125 points to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.
- Qualifies for: KBIS Insurance British Novice Championship - Second Round.
- Qualifying period yearly 1st May - 30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four KBIS Insurance British Novice First Round competitions held in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in and attend four KBIS Insurance British Novice Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular KBIS Insurance British Novice competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Class 2 **Nupafeed Supplements Senior Discovery - First Round**

Entry Fee - £13.00

Rule 314. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.00m.

- Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.
- For Horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 225 points. Four Double Clears will qualify - in accordance with Rule 314.6.
- For all horses that are five years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for double clear qualification to Second Rounds if they reach the age of five years or under in the same calendar year as the Discovery Final - in accordance with Rule 314.6
- Qualifies for: Nupafeed Supplements Discovery Championship Second Round.
- Qualifying period: 1st May-30th April inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the first round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four First Round competitions held in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in and attend four Second Rounds, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). Horses in the class must go in to the jump-off and go clear to gain a double clear round qualification. The winner of a particular First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

Prizes: 1st: £30.00, 2nd: £22.00, 3rd: £15.00, 4th: £13.00, 5th: £13.00

Class 3a Lord and Lady Equestrian Senior Newcomers - First Round/1.10 Open

Entry Fee - £15.00 Rule 312. Single Phase. Speed 325mpm. Start Height 1.10m.

- In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section.
- Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.
- For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 312.6
- For all registered horses that are six years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Senior Newcomers Final - in accordance with rule 312.6 Four double clears to qualify.
- Four double clears will qualify for the Senior Newcomers Second Rounds.
- Qualifies for: Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round.
- Qualifying period 1st June - 31st May inclusive.

Numbers to qualify: Those horses which jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competitions in any qualifying period, will qualify to compete in a Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money in those competitions, which will be determined by the normal Table A Rules (Rule 191). To obtain a double clear qualification, even if the horse is the only clear round, it must jump a jump-off round and jump clear to gain a double clear round. The winner of a particular Connolly's RED MILLS Senior Newcomers First Round competition will not automatically qualify solely as a result of that competition.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money.

For registered horses in Grades: A, B & C. Ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members who will be aged 12 years or over in the current calendar year. Horses may only compete in one section

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses / ponies may only compete in one section.

Prizes: 1st: £40.00, 2nd: £30.00, 3rd: £23.00, 4th: £15.00, 5th: £15.00

Class 4 The Polly Phillipps Memorial Perpetual Trophy

Restricted A&B and C Handicap Competition

Riders are requested to wear hunting dress in this competition.

Entry Fee - £20.00 Rule 284. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Heights Grade C 1.25/ Grade A&B 1.35

- Horses may only compete in one section.
- For registered horses in Grades A, B & C ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.
- Horses will be permitted to jump in the larger section of the handicap competition without penalty. Horses may only be entered in one section.

The Polly Phillipps Memorial Perpetual Trophy Restricted A&B and C Handicap Competition. The top 70 in the GOLD Horse/Rider Combination League Spring/Summer 2019 from 1st April 2019 to 30th September 2019, and ANY RIDER who has represented Great Britain or Ireland as a team member in any Senior International team in the last 5 years (Nations Cup, World or European Championship, or Olympic Games) MAY NOT RIDE A GRADE 'A' horse in this competition but may ride a Grade B or C horse. Grade C horses will be permitted to jump in the larger section without penalty in accordance with rule 77.4

A Trophy, Framed Photograph and a Sash will be awarded to the Winner.

Class 5a Equitop GLME Senior Foxhunter – First Round /1.20M Open

Entry Fee - £16.00

Rule 310. Table A7. Speed 350mpm. Start Height 1.20m.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section.

Foxhunter section:

- For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6
- For all registered horses that are seven years or under at the year that the final is going to be held, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.
- Four Double clears will qualify for the Senior Foxhunter Second Rounds. Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive.
- Those horses that have qualified for the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2019 are not eligible for qualification to the 2020 Championship.

In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split and two sets of prize money awarded. Horses may only compete in one section.

Prizes: 1st: £50.00, 2nd: £40.00, 3rd: £30.00, 4th: £18.00, 5th: £16.00

- Entries will be taken on the day only cash or cheques accepted ONLY. Entries are confined to registered horses ridden by members of British Showjumping in accordance with rule 77
- If there are more than 25 starters all the prizes offered in the schedule must be awarded with the exception that any competitor who is eliminated or retires from the first round of the competition is not eligible to receive prize money in that competition. Rule 76.6.

- BLUE TICKETS HAVE NOW BECOME DAY TICKETS TO RIDE AND NEED TO BE PURCHASED IN ADVANCE FROM BRITISH SHOWJUMPING.** If you are not a member or your horse is not registered with British Showjumping (BS) then you will need to purchase a DAY TICKET TO RIDE – this acts as a day membership for one horse/rider combination (you can jump more than one class per day) at a cost of £5. 5. "RULE 82.19 No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury".
6. Improper Conduct. Any Exhibitor or Exhibitor's employee, or any member of the general public, who conducts himself in an improper or offensive manner to any Judge, Member of the Committee, Steward or Official, shall be reported to the Chairman. He may be refused entry to the Show Ground, may not be allowed to compete in that Class or further Classes and may have no monies refunded. He may not be allowed to renew his subscription or enter any future Shows until re-admitted by the Committee.
